

Funds in Court may have done something you do not like.

You can complain.

There are 3 types of complaints.



1 You are not happy with the Senior Master.

For example,

- you want a new car. The Senior Master said
 you can **not** use your court money
- you want an overseas holiday, the Senior
 Master said you cannot use your court money

2 You are not happy with the Judicial Registrar

For example,

- you want a house. The Judicial Registrar said
 you can **not** use your court money
- you want a new computer, the Judicial
 Registrar said you cannot use your money
 court money



3 You are not happy with a staff person



For example, a staff person

- was rude
- did **not** listen to you
- gave you the wrong information.
